April 2018 Survey Results

Overview

An initial sustainability engagement survey was conducted in September 2013 as part of the development of Your Organization's Sustainability Master Plan. A Sustainability Engagement Score for Your Organization was calculated based on results connected to the dimensions outlined in the left hand column of the table below. All scores are calculated out of 100.

In order to track progress, the same survey was administered again to Your Organization every year for the past four years, with the most recent survey being administered in April of 2018. The staff participation rate was 42% (n=359). Your Organization's goal to achieve an overall score of 70 was achieved as of April 2018, a significant improvement from the baseline. The findings are noted below.
