SSA Group, who partners with cultural attractions bundling food, retail, and admissions services, has a long track record of sustainability successes. Our work to co-create a Sustainability and Climate Action Plan (SCAP) with SSA deepens their long-standing commitment to our planet by identifying strategies to reduce greenhouse gas emissions and build climate resilience.

SSA operates more than 75 sites in zoos, aquariums, museums, and other cultural attractions across the country. Working with SSA has strengthened our familiarity with operations, waste management, and resource use at zoos and aquariums. Importantly, we leverage that expertise to strategically engage employees in SSA’s vision to have a regenerative impact.

SSA is already a sustainability leader. For example, their sites at the Monterey Bay Aquarium and Houston Zoo, respectively, recently became the first and second AZA-accredited institutions to eliminate single-use plastic packaging in gift shops. By enthusiastically co-creating an actionable SCAP, SSA leadership is aligning around a shared vision and identifying clear next steps to ensure they become a thriving and resilient leader for generations to come.

Challenges

1. SSA needed to communicate its efforts and successes both internally and externally.
2. Due to operations being spread across so many different sites, it was more difficult to collect the utilities data required to baseline emissions and drive decision making.
3. As a food, retail, and admissions services provider, SSA relies on external industries such as agriculture and manufacturing whose sustainability efforts are outside their control.

Solutions

1. We are providing engagement support throughout the project. One example of this work is a resource-rich website that provides employees with educational materials on climate change and sustainability, progress updates, and opportunities to participate.
2. In order to get a complete picture of SSA's utility usage, we investigated how the data is measured at each unique site type and analyzed our findings to meet their needs.
3. SSA doesn't shy away from the challenge of accelerating sustainability on an industry-wide scale. Recognizing their influential role in a consumption-based industry, they differentiate themselves through responsible procurement and a regenerative vision.

Impact

Through expertly facilitated workshops and interviews, the SSA team better understands the diversity of impacts they can deliver to their partners. This brings clarity and excitement around why they are taking action to combat climate change and creates space for discussions about going beyond sustainability. Strategic engagement drives much of this progress. We value the input of all stakeholders and include them whenever possible via surveys, communications content, and other means.
